MOTIONS/RECOMMENDATIONS POSTPONED FROM TOWN COUNCIL MEETING JANUARY 26, 2016:

WEST END LANDS DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT AMENDMENT

- Council approved the application by Viking Ventures to amend the Development Agreement registered against PID 5526837 (the West End Lands), to permit four (4) additional lots with a single means of exit from the lands via a public street.

MOTIONS/RECOMMENDATIONS FROM COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE MEETING FEBRUARY 2, 2016:

AMENDMENT TO THE WOLFVILLE L'ARCHE HOMEFIRES SOCIETY PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION POLICY 140-008

- The purpose of this policy is to provide for a tax exemption for Wolfville L'Arche Homefires Society for a new facility purchased at 341 Main St in Wolfville while the facility is under renovation and unavailable for programming.
- The amendment amended the expiry time for the exemption from a specified date of December 31, 2015 to that of expiring when occupancy is issued for the development approved by DA 13-07, or any subsequent amendments.
- Council approved the amended Wolfville L'Arche Homefires Society Property Tax Exemption Policy 140-008.

MOTIONS/RECOMMENDATIONS FROM SPECIAL COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE MEETING FEBRUARY 16, 2016:

FIRE INSPECTION POLICY 220-002

- Under the Provincial [Fire Safety Act](#), municipalities are required to have a system of fire inspections to undertake the necessary inspections to enforce the [Provincial Fire Safety Regulations](#).
- The proposed system of municipal fire inspections policy is intended to better improve life safety and fire prevention and respond to the municipality's responsibility pursuant to the *Fire Safety Act*.
- Council adopted the System of Municipal Fire Inspections Policy 220-002 as per the [Nova Scotia Fire Safety Act](#) and Regulations.
