MOTIONS/RECOMMENDATIONS FROM PUBLIC HEARING, APRIL 17, 2018

PADDY'S PUB DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT AMENDMENT

- Council approved the amendment to the development agreement at Paddy's Pub, allowing for more seating, and outdoor music.

MOTIONS/RECOMMENDATIONS FROM COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE, APRIL 3, 2018

CROSSWALK SAFETY AND FLAGS

Council will be reviewing the intersections along Main Street to determine which could benefit from Crosswalk signage and safety flags to make getting across the street a safer endeavor.

WATER RATE STUDY

G.A. Isenor Consulting Ltd in Association with Blaine Rooney Consulting Ltd. have conducted a Water Rate Study and identified the need for a new rate in the town of Wolfville, which has been untouched since 2004. The rate adjustment is pending review by the Nova Scotia Utility & Review Board.

ACCESSIBILITY ADVISORY COMMITTEE

The formation of an Accessibility Advisory Committee has been approved by Council to help guide the Town to a more accessible Wolfville for those with physical, visual and mental impairments.

COMMERCIAL – RESIDENTIAL BUFFERING

Staff will explore new buffering methods in a future draft of the Municipal Planning Strategy to bring context sensitive buffering to commercial properties backing on to Residential properties.

FRIENDS OF THE LIBRARY

Council endorsed the formation of a "Friends of the Library" group whose efforts will focus on the community needs, desires, and raising capital contributions for an improved Wolfville Library.

CONFERENCE AND PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT POLICY

Council waived the policy statement stating that incurred fees from missing the early bird deadline be the responsibility of delegates for the 2018 FCM Conference. FCM is a great learning opportunity, and not often held in Halifax.
