James Sanford will sit on the Towns Accessibility Advisory Committee and Director Jen Boyd will sit on Acadia’s committee to make sure the Town and Acadia are in sync with Accessibility efforts that are taking place.</li><li>• Milling and paving on Main Street is causing disruption near Acadia but should be back to right before the Prom Parade, this Monday.</li><li>• The Town of Wolfville will be giving Destination Acadia a grant of \$10,000 to attract Tourism and help fund the Athletics Complex which provides services to the Town, as well as continue giving \$15,000 to Summer/March Break Camp programming and have put \$35,000 to work collaboratively on a business plan for the Acadia Athletics Complex.</li><li>• Kings County is doing a recreational needs assessment which will be considered when drafting a business plan for the Acadia Athletic Complex.</li></ul>
