

Employment Opportunity: Community Climate Action Coordinator



The Town of Wolfville is inviting applications for the position of **Community Climate Action Coordinator**.

Wolfville declared a Climate Change Emergency in 2019 and has been developing a plan and programs to cut its emissions in half by 2030. To realize this goal, the Town is looking for an energetic, passionate, and qualified candidate to coordinate the rollout and implementation of its initial climate action programs. This is a full-time, 6-month term position with potential for both extension and growth, reporting to the Town's Director of Planning.

The Community Climate Action Coordinator will work to bring the Town's emissions reduction programs to the community, businesses and stakeholders.

They will coordinate communications and community outreach efforts, both online and in person. They will liaise with and support program partners to ensure effective delivery and positive outcomes. They will work with Town staff and lead a team of student interns to generate awareness and excitement among local residents and businesses about the potential and need for effective action on climate change. The successful candidate will take on other Planning, Development and Sustainability duties, as assigned.

Candidates will have a university degree in engineering, environmental science, environmental studies, urban planning or equivalent. Previous experience working in a municipal government setting is an asset.

The position requires 35 hours per week, some of which may be in the evening/weekend to promote community engagement.
