That the Public Participation Program as adopted by Council on the 21st day of November, 1983 be rescinded and replaced with the following:

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PROGRAM

MUNICIPAL PLANNING STRATEGY AMENDMENTS

Whenever it is intended to amend the Municipal Planning Strategy Council shall take the following steps to gain public input respecting the proposed amendment(s);

- 1. The Planning Advisory Committee will hold a minimum of one public participation meeting to gain input from the public on the proposed amendment(s). This may be a special meeting called for this purpose or as part of the agenda of one of the regular committee meetings;**
- 2. The date and time for the public participation meeting(s) and a description of the proposed amendment will be advertised in the local newspaper once a week for two consecutive weeks, the first ad to appear at least fourteen clear days prior to the meeting;**
- 3. A notice of the meeting(s) will be posted at the Town Hall on or before the day of the first newspaper advertisement of the meeting;**
- 4. If the proposed Municipal Planning Strategy amendment(s) includes an associated rezoning of lands, a letter of notice of the public participation meeting(s) will be sent by ordinary mail to all assessed property owners within 100 meters of the property to be rezoned.**
- 5. Information respecting the proposed amendments will be made available to the general public at the Town Hall. This information will include such things as; staff reports, drafts of the proposed amendment(s), and submissions made by an applicant.**
