Each year, the Town of Wolfville recognizes the significant contributions of individuals who volunteer their time and skills to provide services and programs in the Wolfville community. We are proud to honour our volunteers, and look forward to selecting one of the nominees to represent Wolfville at the Provincial Volunteer Awards Luncheon in April.

#### **Nomination Criteria:**

- An individual volunteer award is open to anyone who demonstrates initiative, leadership, and creativity in his/her service to others, serves as a role model for others, inspires others to engage in volunteer service, and improves the overall quality of life of Wolfville and its community members.
- Nominees must be nominated for **one** of the individual award categories (see page 2). Please consider which award category best fits the individual you are nominating.
- The nominee's efforts are voluntary and above and beyond any immediate remuneration.
- This is a judged process; all areas of the nomination form must be completed for it to be considered.

#### **Award Selection Process:**

- All nominations are judged. One award is allotted for each of the individual award categories for which a qualifying nomination has been received.
- All nominees will receive a letter in March to notify them of their nomination, thank them for their community contributions, and invited to attend our Volunteer Awards Ceremony and Reception.

### INDIVIDUAL AWARD CATEGORIES

#### **Leader of Tomorrow**

Awarded to an individual, under the age of 18, who demonstrates the strength of youth in our community and has significantly participated in or created a project or initiative leading to community enhancement.

# **Youth Program Leader**

Awarded to an individual who supports our community's youth through the development, provision, and/or participation in youth programs and activities.

# **Emerging Leader**

Awarded to an individual who is a new volunteer whose contributions made, or are making, a positive difference in Wolfville. Generally, nominees in this category have volunteered for no more than 2 years.

## **Community Leader**

Awarded to an individual who has made exceptional contributions to community services in Wolfville, either through delivery of these services or in the creation of a program or initiative which has led to the improvement of the social well-being of individuals and families in our community.

# Arts Heritage & Cultural Awareness Leader

Awarded to an individual who seeks to preserve Wolfville's history / culture by sharing it with others and making the community more vibrant. They have promoted arts and cultural development by organizing events or advocating arts and culture ideas or philosophies with positive impact on the community.

#### **Environment Protection & Enhancement Leader**

Awarded to an individual who demonstrates an outstanding commitment to the promotion and preservation of Wolfville's natural environment for present and future generations. They have shown success in the creation and/or delivery of a public or private environmental initiative.

#### **Sports & Recreation Leader**

Awarded to an individual who has volunteered their time to strengthen sports and recreation and enhance the quality of physical activity in our community. Through coaching, mentoring, or program development, this individual has made a positive impact on our community.

# **Leader of Lifelong Achievement**

Awarded to an individual who, over the course of their lives, has dedicated many years of volunteer service in any area to the improvement of Wolfville. Generally, nominees in this category have been volunteering for more than 20 years.
