**Bylaws and Regulations** 

## Exhibit "C"

*Resolved* by the Town Council of the Town of Wolfville pursuant to Section 169, Towns Act, R.S.N.S., 1967, Chapter 309, that the following bylaw be and the same is hereby enacted and that the Clerk be and is hereby instructed to forward same to the Minister of Municipal Affairs and the Minister of Highways with a request for their approvals thereof.

- 1. The Council does hereby close to public use a street or a portion of a street hereinafter referred to as Sunset Drive Extension.
- 2. The street or portion thereof that is hereby closed to public use pursuant to s. 1 of this bylaw is as follows:

All that certain lot, piece or parcel of land situated at Wolfville, in the County of Kings, and Province of Nova Scotia, and shown on a plan of Blomidon Subdivision approved by the Wolfville Town Planning Board on January 12, 1968, and on file at the Registry of Deeds Office in Kentville as Plan Number A-988, which lot is more particularly bounded and described as follows:

COMMENCING at a point on the west side line of a proposed street leading south from Pleasant Street, the said proposed street now known as Riverview Avenue, at a point where the said west side line is intersected by the northern boundary of Lot #5 of the said subdivision;

THENCE south 75° 30' west a distance of 101 feet to the east boundary of lands now or formerly of J. G. MacLellan;

THENCE north 7° 55' east along the east boundary of the MacLellan lands a distance of 54.5 feet to that point on the east boundary line of the MacLellan lands where it is intersected by the south boundary of lot #4 as shown on the said plan;

THENCE north 75° 30' east along the said south boundary of lot #4 to the west side line of the said proposed street now known as Riverview Avenue;

THENCE following the curve of the said proposed street in a generally southerly direction to the place of beginning.

The said lot being a proposed extension of Sunset Drive, extending westwardly from the west side line of Riverview Avenue.

3. The street or portion thereof referred to as Sunset Drive extension as described in s. 2 of this Bylaw is hereby closed and all rights of public use heretofore as a street in the lands hereinbefore more particularly described are forever extinguished and the said Town may sell and convey the street or any portion thereof.
