**Wolfville, NS** – A special election has been called to fill a vacancy on Council. The nomination period closed at the end of day on November 15 and there are now 3 (three) candidates on the ballot.

### Voter qualifications

You will be able to vote in Wolfville's special election if you meet the following criteria:

- You are 18 years of age or older and a Canadian citizen on or before the first advance poll day (December 1, 2022);
- You have been ordinarily resident in Nova Scotia for 6 months before the first advance poll day (since June 1, 2022); and
- You are ordinarily resident in the Town of Wolfville and have been so since immediately before the first advance poll day (as of December 1, 2022).

*By casting a ballot or by entering the electronic voting system and entering your assigned PIN number, you are declaring that you are eligible to vote in this election.*

### Voting

Wolfville will be using a hybrid voting system that provides internet, phone or in-person options for returning your ballot. The electronic voting period (internet and phone) runs from December 1 to December 9, 2022.

Your voter's letter will be mailed on Tuesday, November 22. It contains your unique PIN and instructions for online and phone voting.
