You will provide leadership in business service delivery and will plan, coordinate, direct, and deliver IT support to all Town departments.

Reporting to the Director of Financial Services, the successful candidate will have experience and knowledge in: monitoring security, performance and general health of hardware and software components; forecasting needs and requirements for IT applications, hardware, networks and supporting technology; providing technical problem solving assistance; facilitating business improvement processes; and website support.

You have at least 5 years practical experience along with a related university or community college degree/diploma in computer science. Certifications in security, Microsoft (including Microsoft Dynamics GP), VMWare are an asset.
