



Employment Opportunity: Operator/Labourer Class 1

The Town of Wolfville is inviting applications for a temporary, full time Operator/Labourer Class 1 in our Public Works Department to backfill a leave of absence. The term is estimated to be 6 months, but could end sooner or last longer. The successful candidate will be responsible for operating equipment and completing labour duties as required for the continued operation of municipal services.

Reporting to the Public Works Lead Hand 1, the successful candidate will be self-motivated and work well within a team environment. Candidates should have a minimum of grade 12 education (or GED), the physical ability and fitness to perform moderate to heavy physical tasks and a valid class 3 Nova Scotia driver's license (with air brake endorsement).

The current wage for this position is established at \$24.20 as per the collective agreement between the Town of Wolfville and Service Employees International Union, Local 2. Regular hours of work are Monday to Friday 8:00am to 4:00pm (40 hours per week), with additional overtime as duties require and after hours "on-call" coverage on a rotating basis.
