**Kings County, NS** – The Kings Regional Emergency Management Organization (REMO) will be training municipal staff and supporting agencies in response to a Flood-Evacuation scenario on Thursday, April 20<sup>th</sup>.

Residents of the Meadowview area of Kings County may notice Valley Search and Rescue (VSAR) and Kings RCMP in their area on the morning of Thursday, April 20<sup>th</sup>, as they will be distributing Flood-Evacuation awareness packages to community residents within the area west of the Valley Regional Hospital along Brooklyn Street.
