

PUBLIC NOTICE

TOWN OF WOLFVILLE

WINTER PARKING REGULATIONS

Effective December 1, 2023

Winter Parking Regulations will be in effect from December 1, 2023, up to and including March 31, 2024 on all streets in the Town of Wolfville, including public parking lots (unless otherwise posted).

During this date range, parking of vehicles in these locations is prohibited from 12:01 a.m. to 6:00 a.m., and from <u>one</u> hour after the start of a snowfall to <u>two</u> hours after the snowfall has stopped.

Physicians, fire, and police officials are exempt from these Regulations while carrying out their official duties, as are operators of commercial vehicles while loading & unloading.

Any vehicle in violation of the Town of Wolfville Winter Parking Regulations will be ticketed and/or towed at the expense of the vehicle owner, according to Section 139 of the Nova Scotia Motor Vehicle Act.
