
















Spring 2024 Clean-up in Town of Wolfville

Your regular garbage day is **Friday Week 2** - your **Spring Clean-up week is 22nd - 26th April***
Items must be curbside on Sunday, 21st April to guarantee collection.

***Please note that Clean-up happens the opposite week to your regular collection.**

- The truck will collect **ONCE** during your clean-up week. No specified day or time. Collection starts at 7 am.
- Items **NOT** collected during clean-up are the responsibility of the landlord/homeowner and must be removed from the roadside at the end of the clean-up week.

 Things that <u>ARE</u> accepted	CLEAN-UP INFORMATION	 Things that are <u>NOT</u> accepted
 <p>Household appliances like a washer, dryer and stove. Please note: Any cooling devices like fridges, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers must have a CFC sticker. Limit is two appliances at one stop.</p>  <p>Furniture items like a sofa, mattress, shelving. Any one furniture or appliance item can weigh up to 91kg (200lb): other items must weigh no more than 34kg (75lb) each. Carpet should be rolled in 4ft lengths.</p>  <p>Miscellaneous items such as a water tank, boiler, empty oil storage tank (which must all be drained).</p>  <p>Construction Waste lumber or loose items must be bagged or tied securely in bundles no longer than 1.2 metres (4ft). Nails should be bent over or removed.</p>  <p>Small Auto Parts (no fuel or fluids)</p>		 <p>Cooling Devices like fridges, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers without a CFC sticker.</p>  <p>Electronics like televisions, computers, monitors, stereos, printers, telephones, microwaves and stereos are free to bring into the management centre or participating EPRA locations as part of the electronics program.</p>  <p>Automotive Tires Up to four rimless tires a day can be returned to any tire dealership, free of charge.</p>  <p>Large Auto Parts</p>  <p>Cardboard boxes can be flattened and bundled in 3ftx2ftx1ft and up to two bundles can be put out with your regular collection.</p>  <p>Garden Waste</p>  <p>Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) - Please see the page above November for more details of what is accepted</p>  <p>Household and Lithium Batteries*</p>

Spring 2024 Clean-up in Town of Wolfville

***Please note that Clean-up happens on the opposite week to your regular collection.**

- ♦ The truck will collect **ONCE** during your clean-up week. No specified day or time. Collection starts at 7 am.
- ♦ Items **NOT** collected during clean-up are the responsibility of the landlord/homeowner and must be removed from the roadside at the end of the clean-up week.
- ♦ **No more than 20 items** per household. An item is a single object, a bag or a securely tied bundle measuring no more than 1.2 metres in length.
- ♦ Bagged garbage must be in **clear** transparent bags. Small items must be bagged.
- ♦ **No more than 2 of any one appliance type** (e.g. washing machine, stove, water tank, etc.) will be collected at any one stop.
- ♦ **Items not collected during clean-up are the responsibility of the resident and must be removed from the roadside at the end of their clean-up week.**
- ♦ Lumber, carpet or loose items must be bagged or tied securely in bundles no longer than 1.2 metres (4 feet). Nails should be bent over or removed for safety reasons.
- ♦ Any one furniture or appliance item must weigh **no more than 91kgs (200 lbs)**. Other items must weigh **no more than 34kgs (75lbs)**.
- ♦ Fridges, freezers, water coolers, and air conditioners/cooling devices cannot be collected because of the refrigerants (CFC's). The Eastern Management Centre at 100 Donald Hiltz Rd. in the Kentville Business Park will accept and service refrigeration units for a \$20 fee.
- ♦ **The truck will collect ONCE during your allocated Clean-up Week. No specified day.** Please check our calendar, the Clean-up week table or social media to determine your Clean-up Week.
- ♦ Household Hazardous Waste (HHW), electronics, cardboard, recycling, leaves, garden waste or compost, tires, household and lithium batteries are **NOT accepted for Clean-up.** Please remove batteries from items.
