



Employment Opportunity: Programmer – Community Recreation

The Town of Wolfville is inviting applications for a full-time permanent Community Recreation Programmer to join our team. The successful candidate will be responsible for organizing and implementing engaging recreational programs, activities and events within the Town of Wolfville that promote physical and mental wellbeing while satisfying the needs of Wolfville's residents.

The Programmer, Community Recreation will be responsible for developing, delivering, and evaluating activities related to community recreation, health and wellness with a lens to access and inclusion. The Programmer works as part of a team within the Department of Community Development and with other members of the organization. The position requires someone to be constantly working to create and foster recreational opportunities in Wolfville. Specific attention to be given to the promotion of recreation activities, social and emotional wellness, and connecting people with nature and the Town's open spaces.

This position requires 35 hours per week and will include some evenings and weekends due to the nature of the position.

The annual salary will be dependent on qualifications and experience.

A Criminal Records Check, Vulnerable Sector Check and Child Abuse Registry Check will be required.
