## **Kings District Employees**

Our District Commander for Kings, Inspector Rob Jodrey, is now on leave prior to his retirement. His replacement, Inspector Bill Collier, was just selected in the last few weeks and will arrive in mid-August. In the interim Superintendent Jason Popik, the Southwest Nova District Policing Officer, is running Kings District RCMP. S/Sgt. Ed Nugent continues to manage Operations for Kings. Sgt. Mitch Pelletier is off work presently and Cpl. Greg Charlton is now filling his position in an acting capacity. Cpl. Travis Collins is helping out with Wolfville matters.

Of the forty general duty constables who police Kings District as first responders, eight are assigned to Wolfville. Kings District constables are supervised by eight corporals, two sergeants, and one staff sergeant.

Kings East School Safety Resource Officer Cst. Jennifer Britton left us for a new job in Halifax District last quarter. A replacement will be named before the new school year. The Kings West School Safety Resource Officer is Cst. Jeff Wilson, who is currently off work. Efforts are underway to staff both SSRO positions prior to the start of the 2025-2026 school year.

Cpl. Travis Collins heads up both our General Investigation Section (GIS) and our Street Crime Enforcement Unit (SCEU). GIS consists of two constable investigators while SCEU is an integrated team consisting of two Kings District RCMP constables and one constable from the Kentville Police Service.

Kings District has ten Detachment Services Assistants who perform administrative functions at the three Kings District offices. That of course includes our brand new Wolfville Detachment Assistant, Jaimelee Chambers.

## **Traffic and Pedestrian Safety Reporting**

Road safety was a priority for Wolfville, Kings District, and Southwest Nova Traffic Services members again this quarter, resulting in the issuance of 23 Summary Offence Tickets. Impaired driving investigations were a priority as well; five proactive check-stops were conducted in Wolfville this quarter and three impaired driving related charges were laid. There were no reported pedestrian vs vehicle collisions during this reporting period, although there was one collision between a bicycle and a vehicle that resulted in minor injuries to the cyclist. Only one other collision resulted in injuries, also minor. There were 12 non-injury collisions in the community this past quarter.
