

# Employment Opportunity: **Civil Survey Technician/ Engineering Technician**

The Town of Wolfville is hiring two seasonal Civil Survey Technicians / Civil Engineering Technicians to support municipal infrastructure projects. One position is confirmed, while the second is contingent upon grant funding approval. This opportunity is specifically geared toward youth under 30, including current or returning students seeking practical experience in municipal engineering. Reporting to the *Municipal Certified Engineering Technician* this role will provide site inspection services, create, update and maintain assets and attributes as required utilizing ArcGIS software. This position is pending grant funding approval and will be a minimum of 14 weeks starting in May 2026.

This position does not have direct supervisory responsibilities but works collaboratively within the Public Works/Engineering team and provides hands-on support for municipal infrastructure inspections and asset management. You will also contribute to stormwater and capital infrastructure projects, while working closely with municipal staff and engineering professionals. This role is exciting because it offers students the opportunity to gain practical, real-world engineering experience that directly contributes to the safety and functionality of Wolfville's infrastructure.

We are seeking candidates with a background in Survey Technician, Civil Engineering, Engineering Technology, or related technical studies, along with experience in field measurements, GIS, and infrastructure data management. The role is physically demanding and involves extensive fieldwork, including heavy lifting, uneven terrain, lifting equipment and working outdoors in varying weather conditions. The ability to juggle multiple priorities is essential; in your cover letter, please highlight your experience managing multiple tasks, such as fieldwork, data collection, and documentation.
