Responsible for operating equipment and performing labour tasks as required. Hours of work are primarily Monday to Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. (40 hour work week) although the Town may establish shift work to accommodate seasonal requirements.

- Operates sidewalk plows, and plow/salt trucks in snow clearing operations.
 - Operates backhoe & loader in day to day operations, and snow clearing.
 - Operates other equipment and perform labour duties in various pipe installation and all other maintenance and repair projects carried out by the Public Works Department.
 - Follows all applicable Occupational Health & Safety policies & procedures, and those policies & procedures of the Town.
 - Performs traffic control duties as assigned
 - Performs various other labour duties as assigned.
