This individual will primarily support the promotion of cycling and active transportation through a barrier-reduced equipment loan program. The role requires a highly motivated individual who demonstrates a commitment to cycling advocacy, has demonstrated ability to work with the public, and is self-motivated and can work independently. The successful candidate:

- Has experience with cycling and cycle repair.
- Is comfortable with communicating with members of the public
- Will follow all applicable Provincial and Town Occupational Health & Safety Policies and Procedures.
- Will be required to provide current Criminal Record.

This position is for the remainder of the open-season starting as soon as possible and ending October 25th, 2026. The position will offer 20-25 hours per week.
